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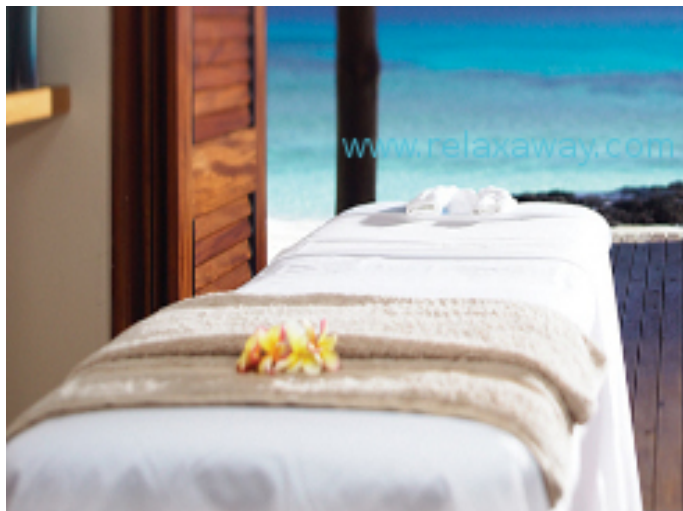
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Yasawa might be an island of isolation, but it's also an island of plenty. All meals are included at Yasawa. The restaurant promises a contemporary cuisine with a particular emphasis on the seafood caught daily in the surrounding waters. Where you choose to eat is your own choice, a night in the restaurant may seem like a great plan or perhaps the next night a beach setting would be more agreeable. The choice is all yours.



Beneath the thatched roof of Yasawa's open-sided restaurant you can choose the best seafood available, offered alongside organic local produce, tropical fruits and fine meats flown from Australia and New Zealand. A table for two with a view of the ocean is guaranteed. If a stroll along the beach is appealing you can do it completely by yourself with little chance of meeting other people. If you are strolling at sunrise you might spot Yasawa's chefs inspecting the catch offered by local fisherman.

To fill your days you may choose to take a picnic on the beach, visit the nearby villages, swim in the crystal waters of the blue lagoon or snorkel among the tropical fish and the coral although many other activities are available. Yasawa Island Resort is surrounded by 11 deserted beaches, you can visit any one and you may have your own little paradise, complete with a boat trip there and a picnic basket prepared by the chief at no extra cost.
